Course Duration
This course can be completed in as little as 6 weeks. Average learning time is 108 hours. This course has a limit of 3 months to complete from enrolment date.
Costs
This course is non funded and costs £150 to undertake. We are able to offer an instalment plan to those that require it but release of certification is not possible until the cost of the course is paid in full.
Who can enrol for this course?
Must be aged 16+. Anyone with pending employment. Anyone who is employed in the health care sector. Anyone who works in health care sector but not necessarily working directly with Children and Young People (for example admin staff, receptionist, kitchen staff,)
Entry Requirements
There are no specific entry requirements however learners should have a minimum of Level 1 in literacy and numeracy or equivalent.
