Course Duration
This course can be completed in as little as 3 weeks. Average learning time is 104 hours. This course has a limit of 3 months to complete from enrolment date.

Who can enrol for this course?
Must be aged 16+. The qualification is appropriate to a wide range of learners especially those on apprenticeship programmes or other training to prepare for work or as part of induction to a job role. It can also be used as part of citizenship programmes for individuals coming to live in the UK
Entry requirements
There are no specific entry requirements however learners should have a minimum of level 2 in literacy and numeracy or equivalent.
