Course Duration
This course can be completed in as little as 3 weeks. Average learning time is 124 hours. This course has a limit of 3 months to complete from enrolment date.

Who can enrol for this course?
Must be aged 16+. Anyone who is employed in the health care sector. Anyone with pending employment in any sector. Anyone who works in health care sector but not necessarily working directly with individual's with Autism (for example admin staff, receptionist, kitchen staff, housekeepers)
Entry requirements
There are no specific entry requirements however learners should have a minimum of level one in literacy and numeracy or equivalent.
