Course Duration
<p>This course can be completed in as little as 3 weeks. Average learning time is 104 hours. This course has a limit of 3 months to complete from enrolment date.</p>
Costs
<p>This course is non funded and costs £120 to undertake. We are able to offer an instalment plan to those that require it but release of certification is not possible until the cost of the course is paid in full.</p>
Who can enrol for this course?
<p>Must be aged 16+. Anyone who is employed in the health care sector. Anyone who works as a volunteer with individuals who have learning difficulties. Anyone who works in health care sector but not necessarily working directly with individuals with learning difficulties (for example admin staff, receptionist, kitchen staff, housekeepers)</p>
Entry Requirements
<p>There are no specific entry requirements however learners should have a minimum of Level 1 in literacy and numeracy or equivalent.</p>
Who is this course suitable for?
<p>This course is designed for</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• already work in Health and Social care but are new to learning disability services• Individuals looking for a career move to work with individuals with learning difficulties• work in learning disability services and want a short qualification for CPD• have a job role not exclusively focused around supporting individuals with learning difficulties, but have some contact and wish to develop relevant skills and knowledge• are community and volunteer carers whose role includes contact with individuals with learning difficulties• have other roles such as employment support worker, education, housing support officers, dementia care adviser or palliative care professional and wish to develop their service to meet the needs of a wider range of service user

- Understand the positive contributions that can be made by individuals with Specific Learning Difficulty in different environments
- Understand the impact of an individual's Specific Learning Difficulty on those around them.
