Course Duration
This course can be completed in as little as 3 weeks. Average learning time is 105 hours. This course has a limit of 3 months to complete from enrolment date.
Costs
This course is fully funded, but there is an initial registration enrolment fee of £25, usually paid by your employer.
Who can enrol for this course?
Must be aged 16+. The purpose of the qualification is to provide updating and continuing professional development (CPD) by developing knowledge relevant to job roles which involve caring for individuals with diabetes.
Entry requirements
There are no specific entry requirements however learners should have a minimum of level 1 in literacy and numeracy or equivalent.
